The Points System:

This points system is in place to encourage participation of all 4H members to actively participate in the club, to have a direct impact on the success of the club, and its members. The points reward system was established to reward those who actively participate in the club. The points accumulated for each 4H member are kept by the Club and Assistant Club Leader. Each member will assigned an ID number for this list to keep our 4H members anonymous to the general public that may view this web site. This list will be maintained online through the horse and pony club website and will be able to be viewed by all. If a 4H member/parent/guardian finds an error in points calculations or points credit for attendance/work at events they need to contact the club leader/assistant club leader to correct any issue. Members have 30 days after results are posted to protest any results or points. Thirty days after posting, results will become official and no changes will be made to the points associated with that show.

What do the Points Count for?

Each year a High point awards are given to 4H members that accumulate points for the entire year (September-August) actively participating in club activities -ex: working at ope shows, tack auction, participation in 4H horse and pony meetings, Hippology, Judging Team, Horse Bowel Drill Team, or other events. The top 47 4H members exhibiting horses/ponies or the top 4 with draft horses with the highest points will be assigned a stall in the south barn at the fairgrounds during the county fair.

Individual Awards (minimum of 30 points to be eligible)

Over all High point for work/participation - In the event of a tie, those 4H members will receive the same award.

High point in is given in the following divisions - 1st year, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior.

These awards will be given out at the annual awards banquet.
